

THE SCHEDULE

OFFENCES IN CONNECTION WITH WHICH PROPERTY IS LIABLE TO BE ATTACHED

1. An offence punishable under section 161 or section 165 of the Penal Code or any conspiracy to commit or any attempt to commit or any abetment of such offence.

2. An offence punishable under section 406 or section 408, or section 409 of the Penal Code where the property in respect of which the offence is committed is property entrusted by ¹[the Government] or a department of ²[the Government] or a local authority or a person acting on behalf of ³[the Government] or department or authority.

3. An offence punishable under section 411 or section 414 of the Penal Code, where the stolen property in respect of which the offence is committed is property such as is described in the preceding item and in respect of which an offence punishable under section 406 or section 408 or section 409 of the said Code has been committed.

4. An offence punishable under section 417 or section 420 of the Penal Code, where the person deceived is ⁴[the Government] or a department of ⁵[the Government] or a local

authority or a person acting on behalf of ¹[the Government] or department or authority.

5. Any conspiracy to commit or any attempt to commit or any abetment of any of the offences specified in items 2, 3 and 4.
