ORDINANCE NO. XXIX OF 1977

[6<sup>th</sup> July, 1977]

**An Ordinance to repeal the Minimum Wages (Fixation)  
Ordinance, 1969.**

WHEREAS it is expedient to repeal the Minimum Wages (Fixation) Ordinance, 1969 (E.P. Ord. X of 1969);

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Proclamations of the 20<sup>th</sup> August, 1975, and the 8<sup>th</sup> November, 1975 and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the President is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance :-

Short title and commencement

**1.** (1) This Ordinance may be called the Minimum Wages (Fixation) (Repeal) Ordinance, 1977.

(2) It shall be deemed to have come into force on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of November, 1973.

Repeal of E.P. Ord. X of 1969

**2.** The Minimum Wages (Fixation) Ordinance, 1969 (E.P. Ord. X of 1969), is hereby *repealed*.
