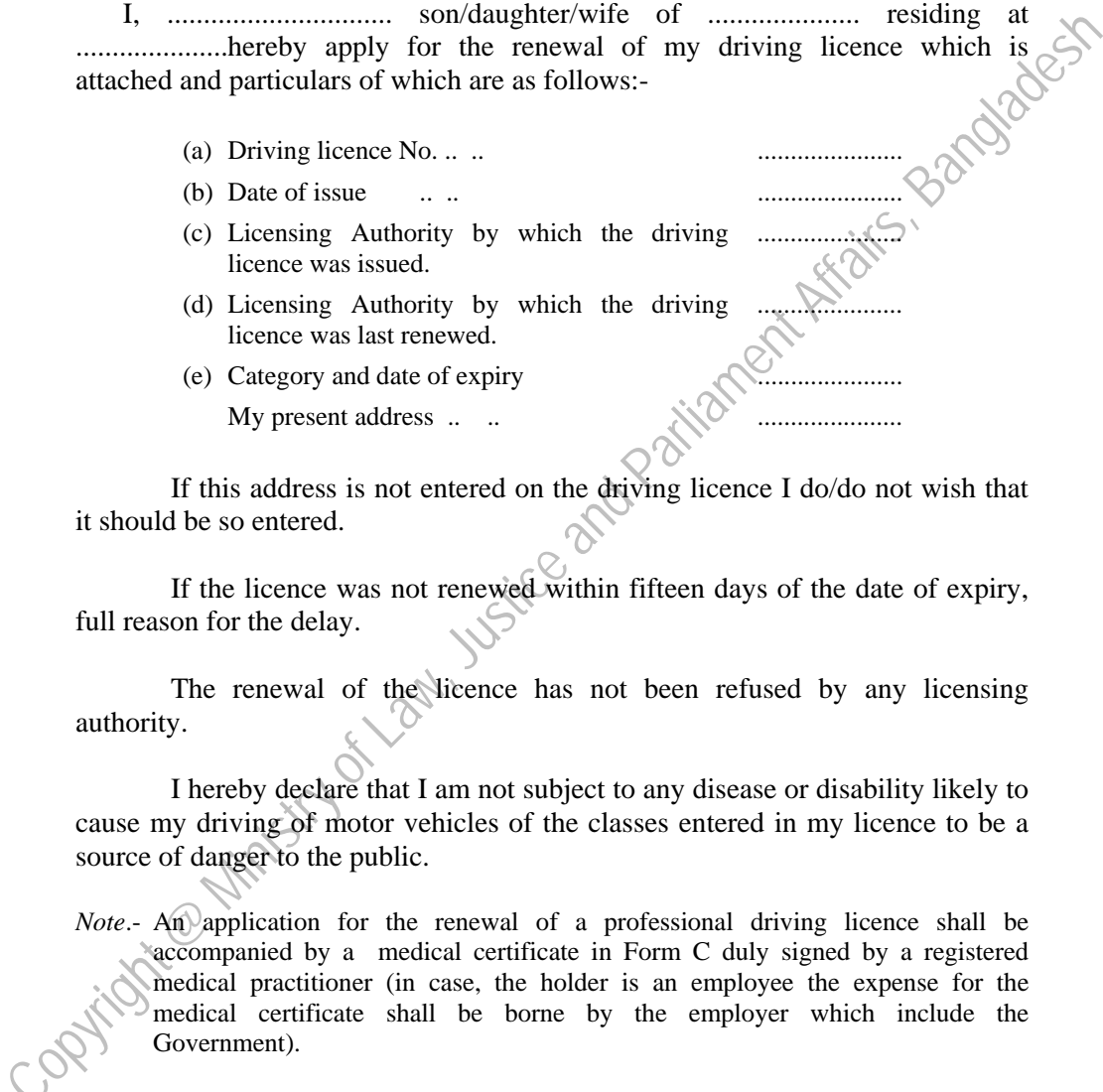

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THE SECOND SCHEDULE

I. Diseases and Disabilities absolutely disqualifying a person for obtaining a Driving Licence to drive a motor vehicle:

3. Heart disease likely to produce sudden attacks of giddiness or fainting.

5. A degree of deafness (without hearing aid) which prevents the applicant from hearing the ordinary sound signals.
6. Inability readily to distinguish the pigmentary colours red and green.
7. Night-blindness.

II. Diseases and disabilities absolutely disqualifying a person for obtaining a Driving Licence to drive a public service vehicle.

1. Leprosy.

THE THIRD SCHEDULE

**Test of competence to Drive
PART I**

The candidate shall satisfy the person conducting the test that he is able to:-

- (1) start the engine of the vehicle,

- (2) move away straight ahead and at an angle while at the same time engaging the first and intermediate gears until the top gear is reached and maintain speed limits of different gears,
- (3) change down to the lower gear quickly from the top gear when the traffic conditions warrant such change,
- (4) overtake, allow to be overtaken, meet or cover the path of other vehicles and take an appropriate course with proper caution giving appropriate signals,
- (5) turn right and left corners correctly,
- (6) stop the vehicle in an emergency and normally and in the latter case bring it to rest at an appropriate course of the road,
- (7) drive the vehicle backward (by looking only at the rear view mirror) and whilst so doing enter opening to the right and left,
- (8) cause the vehicle to face in the opposite direction by means of forward and reverse gears,
- (9) give by hand and by mechanical means (is fitted to the vehicle) in a clear and unmistakable manner, appropriate signals at appropriate times to indicate his intended action,
- (10) act correctly and promptly on all signals given by traffic signs, automatic traffic, lights, traffic police or other authorised persons and take appropriate notice of signs given by other road users,
- (11) demonstrate general control of the vehicle by confident steering and smooth gear changing and braking as and when necessary,
- (12) to change quickly to lower gear while driving down hill,
- (13) to stop and re-start the vehicle on a steep upward incline making proper use of the hand brake without any rolling back.

Note.-(1): Requirements (7) and (8) are not applicable in the case of a motor cycle or tricycle not equipped with means for reversing.

Note.-(2): Requirements (7), (8) and (9) are not applicable in the case of invalid carriage.

PART II

The candidate shall satisfy the person conducting the test that he is:-

- (1) cognisant of the provisions of sections 77, 92,93,94,95,96,97,98, 99,100,101,102,104 and of the Tenth and Eleventh Schedule.
- (2) conversant with the provisions of rules 87 and 89 and the conduct and duties specified under rules 90, 91, 92, 93 and 94 of the Motor Vehicles Rules, 1940, (applicable in the case of candidate who wishes to have professional driving licence);
- (3) conversant with the general traffic rules and regulations relating to the use of lights, parking, stopping the vehicle in an emergency, right of way, controlled pedestrian crossings, meaning of light signals (red, amber and green), one way traffic, driving on channellised roads, driving at night and other relevant matters;
- (4) aware of the traffic signs specified in the Ninth Schedule;
- (5) not so deaf so as to be unable to hear (without hearing aid) the ordinary sound signals and is able to distinguish with each eye at a distance of twenty-five yards in good day light (with the aid of glasses if worn) registration marks of motor vehicles (this shall not apply to person who has produced a medical certificate in Form C).

PART III

The candidate for professional driving licence shall also satisfy the person conducting the test that he-

- (1) has preliminary working knowledge of different parts or system of motor vehicle;
- (2) has knowledge of routine maintenance of motor vehicles;
- (3) knows the use of First Aid;
- (4) knows use of Fire Fighting Appliances and the precautions to be taken for the prevention of fire;

- (5) knows topping up operation, that is, topping up of battery cells with distilled water, brake fluid in the master cylinder, water in the radiator and engine oil in the sump; and
- (6) knows actions to be taken to control the vehicle that skid and in case of tyre burst.

THE FOURTH SCHEDULE

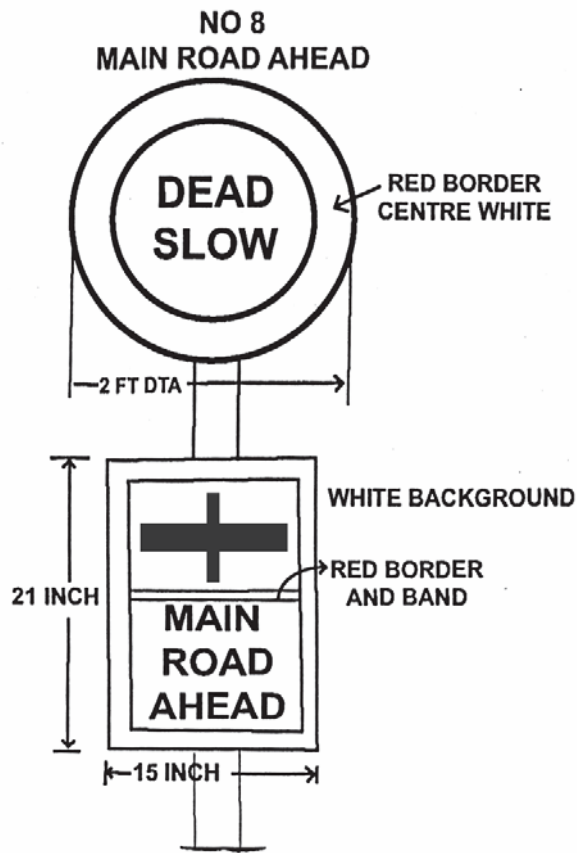

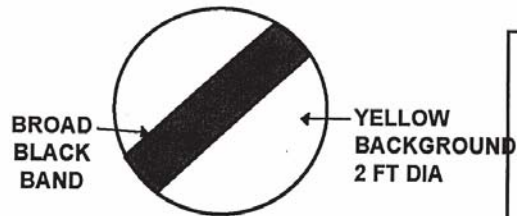
**NO. 1

SIDE ELEVATION**



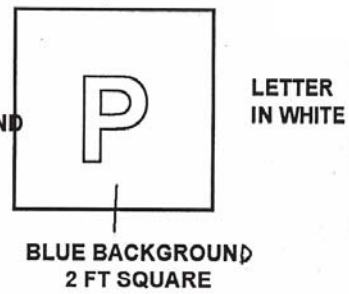

THE TENTH SCHEDULE

(See section 91 and 92)

Driving Regulations.

1. The driver of a motor vehicle shall drive the vehicle as close to the left hand side of the road as may be expedient, and shall allow all traffic which is proceeding in the opposite direction to pass him on his right hand side.

2. Except as provided in regulation 3, the driver of a motor vehicle shall pass to the right of all traffic proceeding in the same direction as himself.

3. The driver of a motor vehicle may pass to the left of a vehicle the driver of which having indicated an intention to turn to the right has drawn to the centre of the road.

4. The driver of a motor vehicle shall not pass a vehicle travelling in the same direction as himself-

- (a) if his passing is likely to cause inconvenience or danger to other traffic proceeding in any direction, or
- (b) where a point or corner or a hill or an obstruction of any kind renders the road ahead not clearly visible.

5. The driver of a motor vehicle shall not, when being overtaken or being passed by another vehicle, increase speed or do anything in any way to prevent the other vehicle from passing him.

6. The driver of a motor vehicle shall slow down when approaching a road intersection, a road junction or a road corner, and shall not enter any such intersection or junction until he has become aware that he may do so without endangering the safety of persons thereon.

7. The driver of a motor vehicle shall on entering a road intersection, if the road entered is a main road designed as such, give way to the vehicles proceeding along that road, and in any other case give way to all traffic approaching the intersection on his right hand.

8. The driver of a motor vehicle shall, when passing or meeting a procession or a body of troops or police on the march or when passing workmen engaged on road repair, drive at a speed not greater than fifteen miles an hour.

9. The driver of a motor vehicle shall-

- (a) when turning to the left, drive as close as may be to the left hand side of the road from which he is making the turn and of the road which he is entering;
- (b) when turning to the right, draw as near as may be to the centre of the road along which he is travelling and cause the vehicle to move in such a manner that-
 - (i) as far as may be practicable it passes beyond, and so as to leave on the driver's right hand, a point formed by the intersection of the centre lines of the intersecting roads; and
 - (ii) it arrives as near as may be at the left hand side of the road which the driver is entering.

THE ELEVENTH SCHEDULE

(See section 93)

Signals

1. When about to turn to the right or to drive to the right hand side of the road in order to pass another vehicle or for any other purpose, a driver shall extend his right arm in a horizontal position outside of and to the right of his vehicle with the palm or the hand turned to the front.

2. When about to turn to the left or to drive to the left hand side of the road, a driver shall extend his right arm and rotate it in an anticlockwise direction.

3. When about to slow down, a driver shall extend his right arm with the palm downward and to the right of the vehicle and shall move the arm so extended up and down several times in such a manner that the signal can be seen by the driver of any vehicle which may be behind him.

4. When about to stop, a driver shall raise his right forearm vertically out-side of and to the right of the vehicle, palm to the front.

5. When a driver wishes to indicate to the driver of a vehicle behind him that he desires that driver to overtake him, he shall extend his right arm and hand horizontally outside of and to the right of the vehicle and shall swing the arm backwards and forwards in a semi-circular motion.
