

- (d) docking of the cattle or dog before its eyes are open;
- (e) amputation of the claws of a dog before its eyes are open;
- (f) inoculation or vaccination of any animal, poultry or bird.

Proceedings in inquiries

22. For the purpose of any enquiry under this Ordinance, the Council shall be deemed to be a Court within the meaning of Evidence Act, 1872 and shall exercise all the powers of a Commissioner appointed under the Public Servant's (Inquiries) Act, 1850 (XXXVII of 1850).

Indemnity

23. No suit, prosecution or other legal proceedings shall be against the Council or any officer or employee thereof for anything which is in good faith done or intended to be done under this Ordinance.

Power to make regulations

24. The Council may, with the previous approval of the Government, make regulations for the purpose of giving effect to the provisions of this Ordinance.
